Mackenzie Smith Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship Criteria:

- Open to any high school senior softball player from one of the following schools- Troy, Piqua, Newton, Milton-Union, Bethel, Tipp City, Troy Christian, Covington, Miami East, and Graham.
- 2. Applicant will be attending an accredited post high school institution. All senior softball applicants will be considered, even if not on a college softball scholarship.
- 3. The requested information that needs to be included is:
 - a. Scholarship application
 - b. Essay
 - c. Current high school softball schedule

Scholarship Process:

- 1. Applications will be sent to the school's guidance department by February, each year via email.
- 2. Applications are due back by March 25, each year.
- 3. All three sections of the application must be completed and received by the due date, to be considered.
- 4. Once all applications are received, redacted copies of each application will be given to the selection committee for review. Each application will be assigned a number that corresponds to the applicant's name. This will be revealed to the selection committee at a later time. The selection committee will be Mackenzie's parents- Dave and Angie Smith.
- 5. The selection committee will narrow all applications down to their top three candidates.
- 6. The selection committee will go watch the three candidates play in a high school softball game.
- 7. Once the committee has watched each player, they will choose the player that best fits their criteria and the committee's decision is final.
- 8. The scholarship recipient and high school coach will be notified and arrangements will be made to present the \$1,000 scholarship check in the recipient's name.

Mackenzie Smith Memorial Scholarship

Mackenzie Smith was a 2017 graduate of Graham High School and the Upper Valley Career Center. She graduated in 2019 as a medical assistant from Edison State Community College. Mackenzie was a standout catcher for the Graham Falcons and Edison State Chargers softball programs. She also played travel ball with the Miami County Blaze, Flames and Ohio Hawks. Mackenzie passed away as a result of a motorcycle accident in 2022. This scholarship is to recognize Mackenzie's hardwork and dedication, on and off the softball field.

Criteria:

- Playing high school softball during your senior year.
- Will be attending an accredited post high school institution. All softball seniors will be considered, including those not on a softball scholarship in college.
- Deadline for submission is by the 25th of March, each year.
