

Scholarship Overview (2024-2025)

Introduction:

The name of the merit-based, non-renewable scholarship herein created shall be known as the "Mote & Associates, Inc. Scholarship." The intention of the Mote & Associates, Inc. Scholarship is to assist commendable students in the attainment of their post high school education in a career in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study. Award:

Selection Criteria:

The recipient will be selected by Mote & Associates, Inc. He or she should exemplify the following criteria:

1) Goals and aspirations in the field of Engineering, Surveying, Architecture, or closely related field of study.

2) Involvement in the community and school demonstrating leadership, interpersonal skills, and social responsibility.

3) Academic ability and motivation to succeed. A personal interview may be requested of the top three applicants.
