

Not all schools look at ACT scores. Some schools will use scores to help with the admissions process and determine school-based scholarships. For example, for Ohio State University, their average incoming college Freshman ACT score is between a 26-32, whereas Sinclair doesn't even consider the ACT score for admissions.






